Councillors **Matt Brereton**, **Anne Hall** and **Simon Fell**, MP for Barrow & Furness, host a special drop-in meeting to hear concerns and ideas from local people and all users of the A590 and tributary roads, to inform strategy of Highways England and County Council Highways and lobby for central government to assist in maintaining, managing and upgrading our vital roads network.
